Researcher at the Department of Planning of the University luav of Venice. She develops studies and researches with the Center Cities of Water on the waterfront development for conferences, workshops and publications.



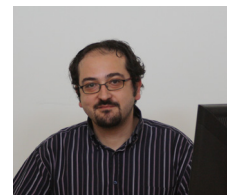
Marta Moretti
